

See-Through Easel and Table Top Felt Board

Assembly Instructions

Package Contents:

- 1 Main Frame
- 2 Side Bases
- 4 Screws

Tools Needed:

Phillips head screwdriver (not included)

Product Information:

This product is **Australian made** using **renewable timber**, finished in a **non-toxic oil** for safety and durability. Proudly crafted by an **Australian family-owned business**.



Assembly Steps:

Prepare Your Workspace

Lay out all components on a flat, covered surface to prevent scratches or loss of small parts.

Choose Orientation

Decide whether you want to assemble the easel in landscape (horizontal) or portrait (vertical) orientation. Both the main frame and side bases are pre-drilled for either setup.

Attach Side Bases to Main Frame

- Align one side base with the pre-drilled holes on one end of the main frame.
- Insert two screws through the holes in the side base and into the main frame.
- Tighten the screws using a Phillips head screwdriver. Do not overtighten.
- Repeat this process for the other side base with the remaining two screws.

Check Stability

- Ensure both side bases are securely attached and the frame stands upright.
- Double-check that all screws are tightened evenly.

Adjust and Use

- Place the assembled easel or felt board on a tabletop.
- It is now ready for use in your chosen orientation.



Tips

1. If assembling for children, ensure all screws are flush and there are no sharp edges exposed.
2. For added stability, check that the side bases are parallel and fully seated against the main frame before tightening all screws.

Both landscape and portrait orientations are supported by the pre-drilled holes. Simply rotate the main frame to your preferred orientation before attaching the side bases.

If you encounter any difficulties during assembly, review the alignment of the screw holes and ensure all parts are oriented correctly.
