How to Assemble the Creatistics™ Reindeer Ornament

1 Gather Your Materials

This kit contains enough supplies to create 12 reindeer ornaments. For each reindeer, you'll need:

- 10 light brown strips
- 2 joggle eyes
- ullet 1 red string (for hanging)
- 2 dark brown antlers (pair)
- 1 red pom-pom nose
- 2 gold metal split pins (paper fasteners)

2 Start with the Top

Insert a light brown strip through a gold metal split pin, using the perforated holes for guidance. Continue adding the strips, one at a time, until all 10 are through the pin. Fan out the strips, then fold back the metal pin securely.

3 Create the Bottom

Repeat the process from Step 2 for the bottom of the reindeer head, threading each strip through the perforated holes and securing with the second gold metal split pin. The strips should now form a rounded head shape.

4 Attach the Nose

Glue the red pom-pom nose to the strip at the front centre of the reindeer ornament.

5 Add the Eyes

Peel the backing off the joggle eyes and stick them on the strips either side of the red nose (position about 1.5 cm alignment above the red nose). These eyes are self-adhesive and do not require glue!

6 Attach the Antlers

Count two strips away from the eyes on each side (towards where the ears would be). Fold back the base of each antler and glue them to the underneath of these strips. Fold back, so the antlers stay upright. **Note**: Position so that the antlers mirror each other, as shown in the image.

7 Add the Hanging String

Loop the red string through the top of the head, underneath the strips at the crown. Tie a knot at the top of the string to create a hanger.

8 Enjoy Your Ornament!

Your cute reindeer decoration is now complete and ready to hang! This makes a great classroom activity.
