

# A Quilt with a Difference

I will need:



scissors

Cut out the steps and make the quilt.

<b>STEP 1</b>	<b>STEP 2</b>	<b>STEP 3</b>	<b>STEP 4</b>

Cut some squares, all the same size, from the paper and from the thick and thin cardboard.	Make a good copy of the shapes on the thin cardboard.	Glue the shapes onto the thick cardboard.	Put the paper on top of the stencil. Roll over the top and then lift the paper off.
Draw some draft shapes onto paper.	Cut the shapes out and arrange them on the thick cardboard.	Roll ink onto the stencil.	Glue all of the pieces together to make a quilt.
