# **Cyber-Team**

### Summary

The city council has decided to sell the soccer field to make way for a new housing development. Karina and her cyber friends decide to do something about it.

#### Features of the Text

- Realistic fiction
- Narrative text that includes orientation, problem, climax, and resolution
- · Use of dialogue
- Use of technology (computer chat room, email, website)
- Computer screen layout, emoticons, and dialogue style
- Use of aliases and abbreviation—a.k.a.

#### **Purpose**

Cyber-Team can be used for the following purposes:

- introducing the ideas and vocabulary in the associated nonfiction title;
- · making connections;
- · exploring dialogue;
- · analyzing characters.

### **Guided Reading Summary**

#### Introducing the text

Discuss the students' understanding of protest.

- Why do people protest?
- What do you think protesters are trying to achieve?
- What kinds of emotions are being expressed?

Explain that this story involves a group of students who work together to make a point. Tell the students that you want them to notice any connections they can make as they read the story.

### Reading and discussing the text

Ask the students to read to the end of page 5.

- How do you think the characters are feeling?
- Why do you think Karina immediately contacted her friends?
- When have you had similar reactions or feelings?

Ask the students to read to the end of page 10, relating the events to their own personal experiences.

- What can you tell about the relationship between these students?
- Why is the ChatZone website a good way to communicate?
- Why do you think the author has included the ChatZone pages?

Ask the students to read to the end of the text.

- What kinds of skills did the characters need to accomplish their goal?
- What message or theme underpins this story?

Discuss times when the students have worked together to complete a task. Discuss any connections they have made with the characters and events in the story.

## Following Up

The students can:

• use the blackline master on page 79 to write a conversation between the friends on ChatZone • design a poster advertising the protest, adding all appropriate details • recount a time when they had to work together as a team to accomplish a goal, explaining the steps that they had to take • identify an issue that they are concerned about and design an action plan outlining the steps that they could take to protest about it.
